Children, obey your parents. (Ephesians 6:1)

11. To what young pastor did Paul write two letters which are books of the Bible?

Timothy

12. Which book of the Bible tells about the beginnings of the Church?

Acts

13. Who helped Paul on his first missionary journey?

Barnabas (Acts 13:1-4)

14. What happened to Saul of Tarsus near Damascus?

Jesus [Christ] appeared to him in a great light, and Saul accepted Him as Lord.

15. Who were Paul's chief helpers on his second missionary journey?

Silas and Timothy (Acts 15:40;16:1)

16. What is an apostle?

A special messenger sent by God.

17. Why did Jesus die on the Cross?

He died for our sins. (1 Corinthians 15:3)

Good news

1. Why do we believe that speaking with other tongues is the initial physical evidence of the baptism in the Holy Spirit?

Because it is the pattern of the New Testament Church (Acts 2:4; 8:14-21; 9:17; 10:46; 19:6; 1 Corinthians 14:18)

2. Why were the Christians at Berea called noble?

Because they received the Word willingly and studied the Scriptures [Bible] every day. (Acts 17:10-12)

3. How did Jesus overcome the temptations of Satan?

By using the Word of God (Matthew 4:4-10)

4. What does the the Bible declare is the beginning of wisdom?

Fear of [respect for] God (Proverbs 9:10)

5. What is the initial physical evidence of the baptism in the Holy Spirit?

Speaking with other tongues as the Spirit empowers [enables] (Acts 2:4)

6. **QUOTATION QUESTION:** What is the mission of the Church?

Mark 16:15 "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation."

7. Is the baptism in the Holy Spirit the same as salvation?

No, Paul asked the Ephesian Christians if they had received the Holy Spirit since they believed. (Acts 19:2)

8. Who is the Head of the Church?

Jesus [Christ] (Ephesians 4:15)

9. **QUOTATION QUESTION:** Why is it important to memorize Bible verses?

Psalm 119:11 I have hidden your Word in my heart that I might not sin against you.

10. **QUOTATION QUESTION:** From Romans chapter one, quote the verse which tells us the power of the Gospel.

Romans 1:16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes. **(FB P. 1394)**

11. **QUOTATION QUESTION:** How did Jesus say we may show our love for Him?
