PACKET OVERVIEW

PURPOSE:

The purpose for the Ohio KidMin Internship Program is to focus on developing the intern's call of God on their life and deploying that call as God leads. Through this internship, the intern will grow as a person, follower of Christ, and a leader. This internship program will provide specialized ministry training and experience and personalized leadership and spiritual development.

Primary Areas of Development

Spiritual

- Interns will leave this program with a full understanding of what it means to be a follower of Christ. We believe here at Ohio KidMin, that everything we do is in vain if it doesn't make Jesus famous. You will learn what it means to pursue God through prayer, the Word, and your personal life. As an Intern, we want you above all else to be intimately acquainted with the voice of God.

Personal

- At the end of this internship, our hope and prayer is that you will become the best version of yourself. We will help you grow in your personal and professional relationships, time-management, and communication abilities. We will continuously encourage you to identify areas in your life that God wants you to grow in and work on.

Leadership

- Ohio KidMin wants to help you grow not only as a person but as a leader. You will be given opportunities throughout your summer internship to learn and grow as a leader. Through the responsibilities given to you, there will be intentional leadership development in areas such as attitude, conflict management and resolution, building and leading teams, program management, event planning, and communicating purpose and vision.

Ministry

- Throughout this internship program you will gain both ministry experience & knowledge. You will begin to learn the ins and outs of church and departmental ministry. Flexibility is key in the Ohio KidMin office.

INTERNSHIP DETAILS & EXPECTATIONS:

Details

- Interns will serve for a period of 12 weeks (10 weeks required) and be required to work 24-32 hours per week. Internship will begin (Tuesday, May 26th, – Thursday, August 13th)
- Interns must be at least 16 years of age and have the ability to drive themselves to the Ohio KidMin office and events.
- Interns will take part in meetings & prayer, be a part of Ohio KidMin events and will be considered team members of Ohio KidMin.
- Interns will be paid \$600.00 (before taxes) throughout their summer internship. Summer housing may be provided by SEU Ohio Network Campus for a small fee.
- All food and lodging will be covered for each event the intern serves.
- There is a thorough interview process for interns to ensure that every person is in a healthy place in their life to be focused on ministry and have the maturity to work well on a staff-led ministry team at Ohio KidMin.
- Interns will be personally challenged in every aspect of ministry and life. They will be equipped within Ohio KidMin to learn how to humbly serve on a ministry team, which is the foundation for great leadership.
- Interns are subject to evaluation and the intern can be terminated at any time due to poor performance or moral failure that would disqualify one from ministry.
- At the end of the internship, interns should expect to have valuable ministry experience and life experience and be sent toward where God may be leading.
- *Interns should not expect to be hired by Ohio Ministry Network at the end of their Internship.*

What OhioKidMin Expects of Interns

- To pursue and honor God with their lives
- To serve on a staff led team
- To be personally challenged and equipped for ministry
- To develop their character and God-given abilities
- To be sent toward where God may be leading them
- To pursue a life of purity and integrity (in dress, behavior, thought, action and word)
- To be able to fulfill the designated Internship time requirement
- To abstain from drug use, alcohol, profanity
- To keep a journal of your experiences & what God is speaking to you

What Interns Can Expect at Ohio KidMin

Mondays - Fridays

MORNING- Personal & Spiritual Development

- Interns should spend time every day in prayer and the reading of God's word. They will take intentional time to read the Word & the books that have been assigned by staff.

AFTERNOON- Vocational Development

- Every afternoon, the intern will get ministry & event experience. They will meet with their staff leader and learn the practical things of ministry.

Events

FLEXIBILITY- Servant Leadership Development

- Our summer will run as follows:
 - June 5th & 6th – Girls Retreat
 - June 7th – 14th – Missions Xtreme
 - June 27th – July 3rd – Family Camp
 - July 10th – 17th – Kids Camp 1 / Starter Camp 1 & 2
 - July 19th – 24th – Kids Camp 2 / Starter Camp 3 & 4
- *Remember: Flexibility is key at Ohio KidMin

Intern Requirements

- Must be 16 years of ages and able to drive
- Must commit to 10 of the 12 weeks of Internship
 - (May 26th, – August 13th)
- Willing to work between 24-32 hours/week
- Must attend all OhioKidMin events
- Must secure housing or partner with SEU Ohio Network campus
- Must consent to background check
